

Attendance

1. All students are expected to be at school every day all day.

Illness

2. If the student is sick, a note from a doctor is required on the third day. .
3. There is no maternity leave policy. If a plan to make up work and a doctor's note are given to the attendance office, we can allow up to one month.
4. An excuse from a doctor's office is required when the student returns from a doctor or dentist appointment.

Suspension

5. Students are expected to be here the day a suspension is over, not the second or third day.

Vacations

6. Students who take "vacations" during the school year will be withdrawn from school and not allowed to return.

Legal

7. A note is required from a probation officer if a student has missed class for court or other legal issues.

Family Emergency

8. Students will not be excused for absences longer than three days if there is a family emergency such as a funeral or if a parent is in the hospital.

We will file with the courts on the 10th day of your student's absences. We will also file with the court for excessive tardies to school. You will be required to attend court and may have a fine to pay, court costs, restitution and be put on probation. In some cases, truancy court results in Social Services becoming involved with your family. Also, frequent absences/ tardies could determine whether your child passes the school year.
